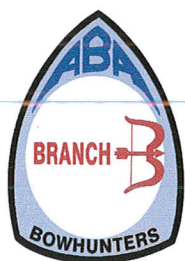

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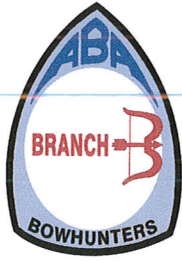

## Yearly Rep Report.

It is good to see the branch running well again, with the many calls from the National Executives cut back to just a few a year.

This year was the reaccreditation year for Measuring, BPC, and Coaching, This saw Amy, Lindsey, and me in Brisbane for this course last month. The courses for our clubs will be rain on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of July at the Townsville club grounds, if clubs don't have their people there, they will have until the 1<sup>st</sup> of Jan 2015 to re-sit their course, or they will no longer be able to do their job for their club. Things have to change and all club ABA reps will have to be the club measurer no more handing paper work around members to get it done and then sent to me, some claims last year were five months late. Start doing your jobs, the job of the rep is to attend club shots (**at least half or three quarters of them in a year**) and to talk to all members of the club and pass on any questions they have that you are unable to answer, and to pass on to them information that has been forwarded to you from me or from the branch committee, if you are unable to do this you are not the member of your club for this job and you should be replaced immediately, because as long as I am doing this job and from now on I will be doing my best to see that the branch is brought up to the standard of all other branches.

Before I get into the 2013 hunting year, Last year saw the TBA muster held at the Wide Bay club, with a few hundred members showing up, but not too many from our Branch, it was very poor to see.

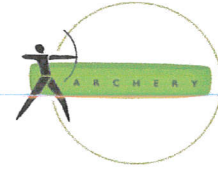
Now for the hunting year, over the last three years 09 has been the better of them with 380 feral animals taken, 2010 was a very poor year with only 198 going down, this year saw a good number of hunters out and about taking plenty of feral animals claimed, 22 hunters took a new First Kill of Species, well done, there were 141 Trophy Class claims sixty odd more than last year, and 24 Record Class animals claimed, along with a very impressive new Australian Record Shark taken by Carol Teitzel, very well done to Carol. But overall it was not too bad a year with 342 claims.

At our AGM on the 7<sup>th</sup> June 2014 one of our Club President from Townsville District Bowhunters and our Branch Coach being Lindsay Yuile submitted a letter to the Branch Regarding the Dropping of Masters and asking for its reinstatement. Lindsay has asked for the Branch to support his letter by passing it on to National level for submission and asking Nationals to re consider the decision that was made.

I know there are many Masters Shooters within our Branch who are not happy with the Decision made to no longer recognise Masters as a Shoot Division. Lindsay is not only voicing his own concerns but those of his fellow shooters.

After listening to and reading his argument as Branch Controller I fully support Lindsay with his submission and his effort to re introduce Masters.

RE: Reintroduction of Masters Grade for competition.

Concern and disapproval has been expressed by many ABA members in relation to the detracting of the Masters grade from competition within the ABA format of field archery.

Rule 1. Philosophy, of the ABA National rules states; *"It is the policy of this Association that the ABA National Bowhunter Round shall in all respects encourage, preserve and maintain the practices of the instinctive format of field archery"*

The detracting of the Masters grade as a competition grade can easily be seen to contradict this philosophy within the national rules with the following points taken into consideration.

1. Many archers have worked tirelessly for many years to achieve a higher level of skill shooting in an instinctive style to achieve a level of skill recognised by the Masters grade of shooter during competition. Archers who have achieved this level of skill are disappointed to have their Masters grading removed. Archers in this position such as Rob Muir (barebow compound)
2. Further, archers who were very competitive within the older A grade division are no longer able to be competitive in A grade due to the inclusion of archers from the higher level Master grade now shooting in the same division. Archers include Trevor Combridge (Barebow Compound) and Lindsay Yuile (Barebow Recurve).
3. With the detracting of the Masters grade, the score window for the A grade instinctive compound, recurve and longbow shooter has increased from approx. 100 points in range to now up to 300 points in range, encompassing a far greater range or level of archers skills. This is at the high end of the ranking scale (barebow shooters shooting in excess of 600 points) and not the low end compared to sighted shooters who now have a new C division for sighted shooters shooting below 600 points.

These examples above, although from the same Nth Qld branch, are not limited to this branch alone. Other archers have also expressed similar opinions and dissatisfaction when the discussion was raised during the National Safari in Wide Bay in April 2014.

The attached 3 pages show extracts from the ABA National Safari results comparing 2013 and 2104 results. The distinction between the two years shows the inclusion of Masters Grade in 2013 compared to the results from 2014 where the master's grade has been removed. Examples shown represent archers from Senior Female Bowhunter/Barebow compound, Senior Male Bowhunter/barebow compound and senior male Bowhunter/barebow recurve divisions.

It is easily identified by the highlighted examples that the archers that were very competitive in 2013 A grade divisions are no longer competitive 2104 due to the inclusion of Masters Grade level archers within the A grade ranking.

It is also easily established in consideration of the total scores for each division, the distinction or great range in-between scores from archers of a 'Masters Grade' level compared to those of the 'A grade' level.

Some A grade archers from the older grading system have stated they will be less willing or inclined to travel and compete at events due to no longer being able to be competitive within the new A grade ranking. The concern that archers would be less willing to travel and compete in local, branch, state or National events would not only contradict the Nation Rules, Rule 1, Philosophy (mentioned earlier) but would also hinder the continuation and maximum attendance at future ABA events, especially in regional areas.

There are many archers who have strived over many years to obtain a level of skill and recognition to compete at a 'Masters' level during competition. The removal of the master's grade in competition has been viewed by some as a detraction from the recognition of these members who have spent so much time devoted to their sport, the association and in developing their skills.

With consideration of these points and concerns, it would be requested, on behalf of many ABA members throughout Northern Queensland and other areas, to give full consideration to reinstatement of the Masters Grade for competition within the ABA rulings and grading systems.

Amy,

First and foremost, I am fully confident that I have not acted outside any guidelines in my actions in relation to Branch matters. If there has been any discrepancy, I have not been made aware of it by any means.

The recent FAI course held at Collinsville was reported to the Branch and National Director of coaching (NDC) from inception. The initial information was even provided at the Branch AGM held in Mackay. Both Branch and NDC were advised of intention to run the course, the expression of interest sent to all clubs, the arrangements for holding the course including dates and participants. Perhaps one oversight was not advising Eric of the course date. I spoke to you personally in relation to the invoice from ABA for course material and you advised me to arrange the relevant clubs provide payment to ABA. This is exactly what I did which was returned to ABA. Further copies of all documents and cover letter to sent to ABA were copied to Branch and NDC for reference.

From this email sent to you I received an email response being unprovoked and aggressive in nature from Mitch telling me to "pull it up" and accused of going behind Branch's back in relation to matters which were not specified or listed.

Mitch was further aggressive in relation to my contacts with the Girl Guide Assoc with discussions of running a Corporate Instructors course for local guide leaders, again referring to breaking guidelines with no actual reference to any actions. As before, all communications with the Guides has been reported to Branch and NDC in all respects. As no formal application for the course has been made at this stage all contacts to date have been of an enquiry nature. My meeting with the guides today was in the form of personal introduction and to discuss with the guides any requirements going forward, including official application to Branch, so that plans can be arranged in the correct manner with all parties concerned.

I was very disappointed with Mitch's conclusion of his email stating that if I didn't "pull it up that Branch may look at other actions". I can think of no other way to interoperate this comment apart from an unjustified threat of dismissal.

Further to the unjustified email in question is the fact that Mitch, rather than contacting me directly to discuss any concerns in a personable manner also contacted Scott Murray by phone and apparently spoke with Scott in an angry manner in relation to me and my actions. I am only aware of this after seeing Scott at his business on my way home from the meeting with the guides. Scott did not elaborate on details of the conversation but did indicate that Mitch was not impressed with me and was not pleasant in his manner. I have bitten my tongue on many occasions in the past concerning Mitch's attitude and actions but this time I have been the subject of what I consider a personal attack of character. I no longer believe that I can continue in such a role as Branch coach and be fully willing to contribute with an ever present threat of vilification as I have experience recently.

I appreciate the offer of time to reconsider but I have already given the matter much thought and my decision has been made. I would suggest that Branch utilise the next 3 months to find a suitable candidate for replacement. My resignation stands.
