- At the AGM it was advised Malcolm Grubb had resigned as Branch B Coach – all clubs are to ask team members to express interest in position of Branch Coach. All courses required are funded by the Branch and coaching for role is available. Mick Beard advises there may be some members in Mackay who are keen in looking at coaching, he will follow up.

- At the AGM it was discussed that there is still issues with the Score Recorders computer and program, Patrick will follow this up and commence investigating the issues around the program.

- Tania addressed the committee and advised that she is very happy to accept the role of Branch Controller and is looking forward to working with everyone in Branch B over the coming months and years.
- James (Rowdy)Unsworth made known he is leaving from Townsville in between the dates 31 July 2016 to 31 October 2016, this will leave the Townsville Club without a full measurer and a new measurer will need to be trained and appointed by then. Actioned to Garry Pitt to follow up on holding a course and the following points for investigation:
 - Uri has expressed interest in the role however a measurer must be a hunter and be prepared to travel when necessary.
 - Trevor Philo stated that Jon Mitchell is keen to attend training to become a full measurer that he would like to attend a course when organised.
 - Discussions around large distances between the clubs in Branch B should we actually be looking at each club in the branch have 2 full measurers (1 gazetted position and 1 phantom position).
 Garry Pitt to approach the ABA and discuss this option of each club holding 2 measurers and clubs to write letters of support to justify application.

- Garry Pitt on behalf of the outgoing branch committee and branch members officially would like to thank Amy and Mitch for all their assistance and everything they have done in their positions over the last few years. Garry has also stated that as per every year he is happy to vacate his position of ABA executive and allow someone else to step into the role, however as per in the past there was no current nominations received by the due date. He had been advised that Tony Lasken was interested in the role of ABA Executive, however we would now need to go to the ABA Executive to ask for him to be appointed to the role, he suggested this is discussed with Eric Creighton and if this is approved than he will gladly step down. However there is now some confusion surrounding this as Tony was thought to be a club member of Charters Towers however he is not a financial member of Towers Bowhunters and he is an independent. Garry is to go back and investigate this further looking at who has actually measured Tony's claims as it was not the Towers Bowhunters measurer. He will advise in due course, Tania to follow up.

- Through the role of ABA Executive and in awarding claims Garry has been in the past issuing Certificates of Recognition for claim to the members, however tonight he has handed out to the club representatives these certificates to present to the recipients. The recent increase in postage costs has seen the postage costs come to a stage where we need to look at alternative options for how these certificates are delivered to recipients :
 - We continue with Garry passing the certificates to club representatives at the general meetings, to then hand out to recipients at a shoot.
 - Postage is continued as per current practice however annual costs will then be passed back to clubs.
 - We look at the club secretary being emailed a soft copy of the certificate to then print a hard copy and issue to recipient.

Trevor Philo recommended that Garry do up a cost approximation of current practice and at the next meeting we will investigate further. *

- Garry Pitt raised that on behalf of the Mt Isa club it was disappointing that only 7 members from the Branch B clubs travelled the distance to Mt Isa for the Safari shoot, and the low showing has made Mt Isa very hesitant to nominate to hold another and it will potentially be a very long time before they put their hand up to enter into this again. He acknowledged that the date and distances were off putting especially as it was so close to the state titles last year. Their club is constantly not receiving support from other branch B clubs through nominations and in fact nominations were so low for their invitational this year that they have cancelled it.
- It was also mentioned that Nationals are also looking to have more Branch nominees attend and are looking at clubs and zones to host food stalls as an incentive as well. Patrick raised that the location being the same every year does not make the shoot appealing for him personally. It was then mentioned that it is and in kind situation, with their being poor showing in Branch B shoots from members of other branches.
- Tania plans to commence a Branch B newsletter and in each she would like to profile a hunter, she looked to Rowdy for this and he suggested perhaps a young shooter up and coming would be better, we have suggested she do both as a "New Blood / Old Blood" story. Nominees for first edition are Rowdy & Shaun Knuth.
- Trevor Philo asked is there a planned hand over for the 2015 exec to the 2016 exec – Amy advised that this has already commenced with her working with Pat this weekend and she will ensure she works with Tania, Jacqui & Bev this Sunday to hand over to them.

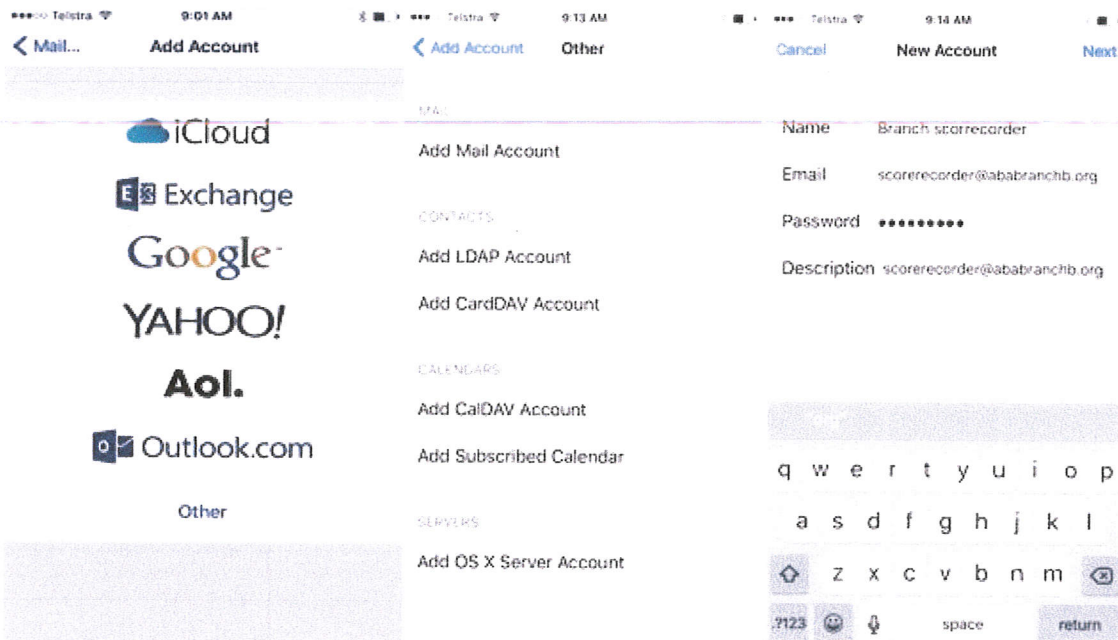

Item 1: Queensland's 'Get in the Game' Initiative

Description: This program is part of a three year, \$100 million Queensland Government

commitment to the *Get in the Game* initiative, which supports individuals and organisations in increasing sport and active recreation participation. The opening of funding rounds up to 2018 have been announced (closing late August/1st September 2016), and Branch B have encouraged their clubs to apply for funding. To be successful for certain grants, the national association requires registration to the program.

Action: National Executive to register ABA with the Queensland '[Get Started](#)' program.

Item 2: Branch B Incorporation

Description: Branch B is currently investigating incorporation under Part 9 Division 1 of the *Associations Incorporation Act 1981* (Qld) (the Act) - Incorporation of branches. The purpose is to allow Branch B to apply for grants that restrict eligibility to a particular local government or region address. Section 74 of the Act allows for the incorporation of a branch pending written agreement of the parent association, and the passing of a special resolution by the branch members. ABA's rules would continue to control membership of the branch, and the members of the branch retain their obligations to the ABA. The incorporated branch would be taken to be a member of the ABA and have the same liabilities and obligation of ABA, as per existing arrangements. The name of the branch would be the Australian Bowhunters Association North Queensland Branch Inc. (or similar). A contractual arrangement may be required with regards to ABA retaining ownership of assets/funds.

Action: National Executive to discuss incorporation options and provide feedback to Branch B

As per section 12(a)(xv) of the Australian Bowhunters Association (ABA) Constitution 'Each Branch shall be entitled to three (3) votes at the National Annual General Meeting. In the first instance, these votes shall be held by the Branch Controller, Branch Field Representative and any other one of the three Branch Executive Committee. Should either the Branch Controller or Branch Field Representative be unavailable then the Branch Executive Committee shall allocate the votes to other elected Branch Executive members.'

The Branch B Field Representative Mr Garry Pitt is also an Officer of the National Executive Committee, holding the position of National Assistant Measurer. Mr Pitt will be attending the ABA Annual General Meeting (AGM) as an Officer of the National Executive Committee. As per s 12(a)(xii), each member present and eligible to vote at a General Meeting of the ABA shall have only one vote. Reading this provision within the context of the section, Officer and member are clearly separate terms (*expressio unius* – see ss 12(a) and 12(b) for context).

However s 12(b)(iv) provides that the National Executive Committee Officer voting is as prescribed for the National Management Committee, implying also a single vote entitlement for Officers present at the AGM. Whereas there is ambiguity whether a person holding both Officer and member positions can vote once for each position, s 12(a)(xi) implies a 'show of hands' physically limits voting to one vote per person present.

As the Branch is entitled to **three votes**, and the Branch Field Representative is unavailable to vote due to conflicting positions, the Branch B wish to advise the Branch B Executive Committee shall allocate this vote to another elected Branch Executive member as per s 12(a)(xv) of the Constitution.

There is a specific section of the Associations Incorporation Act 1981 that is set up for Branches, ensuring they remain part of the parent body. You are correct that the ABA constitution would require slight amendment, with Branch B membership being similar to Trophy Bowhunters Association. It has its own membership section - which I'm not sure is lawful...but moving right along. Assets etc remain ABA through a contractual arrangement. We are merely a body representing the parent. So not as scary as it sounds.

The inspiration behind the branch inclusion to the Assoc Inc Act was the Returned and Services League of Australia (Queensland Branch) Act 1956. In 1995 the Assoc Inc Act 1981 was amended to streamline

legislation, and allow other bodies to similarly regionally incorporate without separating from the control of the parent body. See the Associations Incorporations Amendment Act 1995. Essentially it allows regional control to regional requirements, but still ABA. Food for thought anyhow.

Speaking to people from Branch C there is actually alot of resources and funds from Nationals that are available to our clubs to help build them and keep our membership strong, it seems that perhaps we havent been doing this in Branch B, if we get our clubs working on their development plans we can then use this information to help them source the support we need from the ABA.

With regards to our phone conversation yesterday where I raised concerns of ABA's non-compliance relating to the incorporated association requirements, information retrieved from the public register of association names indicates that ABA has been recorded as non-compliant for both 2014 and 2015. After you advised I was incorrect, I sought clarification from the licensing unit of the Department of Business, Northern Territory Government via a public register enquiry (e.g. as a member of the public). This morning Mr John McLaren, Manager of the Compliance for the licencing unit has advised me that whilst the association is still incorporated, it is non-compliant as financial statements have not been lodged for 2014 and 2015. The Public Officer details may also need to be updated.

Our beliefs and ideas appear to be very similar, both for branch, and for the running of a committee. I definitely prefer to investigate matters fully before raising them. Not only does this save time, but allows for an educated approach to dealing with it. For example, the grant situation raised by Jacqui. There is no point raising a grant suggestion if we aren't eligible. The three or four grants I shared with clubs were after researching and investigating dozens of them. As Jacqui knows this is not as simple as merely reading the grant summary page - there is a lot of work involved pre and post grant applications. With the volunteer base shrinking and the limited time available to the volunteers and appointed positions within ABA national (and with national members being in different states), should we not all work towards assisting with the growth and flow of information to and from nationals, our clubs, and our independent ABA members?

Jacqui is correct in that it is not up to me to submit an application for a grant without Branch endorsement - but I do not need Branch endorsement for day to day operations including researching legislation, grants, eligibility and governance compliance. In my opinion it is wasting the limited volunteer hours we have if we take every item to our clubs without fully investigating them.

I am also of the understanding the Branch Controller is the authority outside of meetings, as per section 8(h) of the ABA Constitution: Branch Controllers shall be responsible for the day to day management of a Branch and shall hold all authority in a Branch whilst the Branch Management Committee and Branch Executive Committees are not sitting, except as otherwise specified elsewhere in this Constitution.

Branch B is essentially a subcommittee to a big team - the National Executive Officers. I encourage networking with this team - they are the source of a lot of the information we lack. I encourage, and expect, a relationship to be established with your national counterparts - Pat with the National Score Recorder, Bev with the National Treasurer, Pity with National Measurer, VP Field, VP Bowhunting etc., Jacqui with Executive Director, Amy with National Director of Bowhunting Education, and so forth, ring your counterpart - they are our lifeline.

Things will come up that we don't understand or have not encountered before, and chances are they've been asked the question by other Branches and have an answer for us. If there was an issue with a request, it needs to be addressed ASAP with those involved - thank you Jacqui for providing your response - can we please in future avoid a repeat by discussing directly with those involved?

Being a lifelong hunter with my archery roots seated with ABA I detest any disrepute being brought against ABA's name, let alone the Branch. Gossip helps no one. I was told other Branches have asked the incorporation question, and as it was a matter for the National Executive Committee, I was requested to put a request for information in writing up to the Exec Officers to get some feedback - this is as per section 9 of the ABA Constitution. So I did so, we all knew what was asked, why it was asked, and what action was asked. As of yet, there has been no feedback, so we've nothing further to discuss on what it actually entails, apart from a couple of wild guesses which aren't helping things. All I owe is an apology for sending the request via the National Secretary - I should have sent it to the National President.

I, like Pat, endorse the idea of a future Branch grounds, but that discussion is probably best for another day.

With regards to the incorporation non-compliance - this was politely raised after I was contacted on a different matter by the National Secretary during a phone call. As I had been somewhat aggressively advised I was incorrect, the follow up email was provisioned to the general secretary for my findings as a courtesy, as this type of issue either perceived or actual can affect ABA as a whole. As Branch Controller, I still retain that I acted within my role, in investigating this is conducting due diligence. This remains my perspective - if there is advice otherwise please forward.

My opinion of the 'status quo' is not high. I clearly stated my intent at Branch AGM that I wish us to grow. We won't grow with status quo. Resistance to change is a natural thing, and an important gauge - therefore I clearly value Jacqui's and the overall committees input. But I won't stand by and watch clubs like Mt Isa struggle to even get other clubs to attend invitationals. We already have a couple of sleeper clubs. I want to put funds into our clubs (ABA equipment, official targets, educational resources, training courses) so that their own funds can be used for membership drives, infrastructure, and whatever they desire.

I've stated over again to clubs, to our committee, to the national exec. The status quo currently is the Branch existing off club funds, whereas the branch should be actively contributing to the clubs. Therefore the status quo does not sit well with me.

How many people do you think buy bows or archery related equipment in our area alone, each year? Would a single sales database of over thirty thousand individuals surprise you? There are many stores in our branch area, and also the availability of online purchases. Where are these buyers shooting? How can we bring them to ABA?

I'm not keen on sitting around for 2 years while we settle in - I'm a mover and a shaker. I may work in what appears to be a backwards fashion, but that is where I am relying on my team to bridge the gaps. Yes, we're volunteers, but that doesn't mean we sit on our hands and wait. I know what the Branch role is, and what it has been. I also know what various clubs want and we are already on the way to providing this - I haven't been just deciding what I want and running off in some strange direction, I've also (where appropriate) been shadowing the previous committee, learning, listening, and working towards providing information for a strategic plan.

To add further clarity to how I see our roles, activities should include:

- Scanning media for archery/Bowhunting/hunting related items, and feeding back to Nationals
- Monitoring State and Local Government regulation for impacts to hunting and archery
- Engaging with stakeholders and community in our area for hunting and archery (e.g. SSA conservation, Archery Alliance members, government, sports bodies) with ABA endorsement
- Risk assessments and compliance management of ABA requirements for all ABA endorsed activities (or supporting clubs to do them)
- Establishing a presence in archery and hunting stores (ABA brochures, club contacts, etc)
- Supporting endorsed archery dealers
- Providing an open and approachable face to clubs
- Supporting come and try day's & membership drives
- Act on the State's behalf (alongside Central and Southern Qld) in representing State matters of significance to the National Exec (see attached image)

If any of us have any problems with these, please say something now. I'm just getting the idea that my perspective of Branch function is completely different to some of our committee. This needs to be identified now so we can work towards a unified approach.

Option 5 I hadnt heard - I dont hunt, I dont shoot at all - I actually dont like hunting but I respect members rights to hunt and shoot as long as they are proficient, I am involved because my husband and kid enjoy the sport.

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Branch B separating - hadnt heard the rumour about separating, but I saw your email about incorporation, and no discussions I have had, has said anything about the AGM even coming into it.

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ACTION: National Executive to discuss incorporation options and provide feedback to Branch B"

This implies that the BRANCH all of the Branch wants you to research this and investigate, this isnt the case though, you had not spoken to anyone in the branch B executive or the club reps, you can not go off asking these queries without making your reps aware of what you want to aim for and making sure that they want this as well, you owe them that courtesy, you also owe Pitty as the field rep and the national measurer a conversation about this, he could have been left to have walked blind into the national committee meeting and copped a hammering as he wasnt even aware of this question being sent to Nationals.

I will even go as far as to say that as I see it, its not our role to be the gatekeeper and holder of grant funds, our role should be to advise clubs of what local grants are available for them to apply for, they have to be able to show the purpose for the grant and account for the grant. When we identify large grants that go towards talent development we should be utilising the ABA to apply for these, that way they can then apply and source the funds to distribute for development programs.

3. Yes well I am sorry but when you "sought clarification from the licensing unit of the Department of Business, Northern Territory Government via a public register enquiry" you are interfering in the ABA's National Business. Yes its a public register enquiry and yes you can justify it to yourself by saying its a public right and you need it to apply for grants, HOWEVER which Branch B club has actually endorsed you to start applying for grants and making these investigations? And which meeting was that actually passed at? I seem to be missing the minutes for that one.

4. Branch Incorporation - I will stand by the advice I was given by the ABA, I do believe if you pursue and push this we will lose, if the National donot vote to change the constitution and I also stand by initial comments of we need to wait until we get to the AGM to find out just what exactly we are entitled too.

This Branch has had years of not accessing what it is entitled too, the ABA wants to work with us to ensure we start accessing it, we are a new committee, take the time to ease in, find out what the branch can access and if its still not enough for what the clubs want then we raise it again with the ABA at that point.

The fact is that we are dealing with a traditional respected association, with multitudes of years of experience behind them, I am not here to challenge the status quo, I am here to help build the strength of the clubs in the branch and thats by finding out whats on offer first. I can appreciate your exuberance and I appreciate that you want to grow the branch, the branch needs to build strength to enable the clubs to grow, they need to be in control of their growth, the thing is we need to learn what the actual branch role is in relation with what the clubs want and what the ABA expect of us. We havent asked them for anything so they havent told us we cant have anything yet.

I still stand by we do not need incorporation, thats not a role we need to be filling, we need to engage the parent body to be looking at grants and

covering the gap if there is any.

I will add though Pat throwing up the other night that if we become incorporated we could have our own parent ground, is a huge red flag, there is absolutely no reason for the branch to be that financial and I dont see that as being a direct benefit to all the clubs

this whole issue is because we all want the clubs in the branch to be strong, but the first stage of this is doing what the clubs want us to do not what we think they need.

I spoke to two club aba reps last week to see if they had heard or been asked for input on the issue of Incorporation, both of them advised no, so i will own that maybe that question has sparked concern.

The big issue contributing to all of this is lack of communication to the club reps and the committee before questions get asked, continuing to push the barrow makes it worse.

We/You have the task of representing what our clubs want, we shouldnt be doing that with out talking to them before we do anything.

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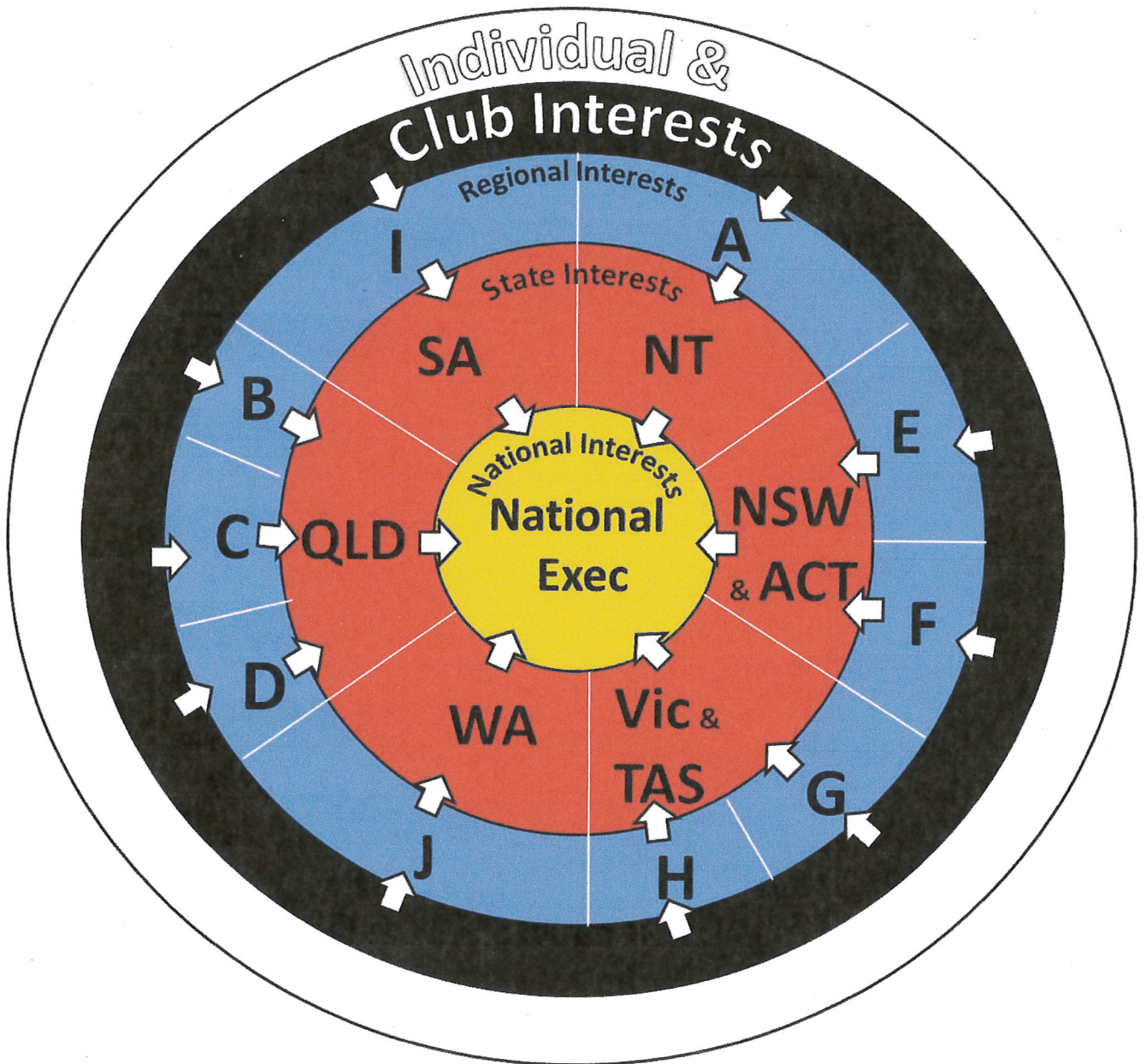

Extra business:

This meeting has been called on request of ABA National Executive to align the new committee and ease the tension currently being experienced.

Meeting held via teleconference. Meeting opened at 07.01pm.

Pat asked the question if we felt the meeting should be minuted, Jacqui replied that if we had enough present to form the quorum she would take the minutes and send out. Pat read sections 12(c)(iv)-(vii) from the ABA constitution and it was decided that minutes will be taken.

Pat opened with reference to the rumours that had been circulating around. Jacqui advised that, similar to her email, she was not aware of any rumours, or had any discussions about Branch B business outside of the committee, other than regarding incorporation, and that was only to gauge club knowledge on the matter. Tania raised that she was frustrated by the rumours and that she wouldn't tolerate disrepute being brought against ABA's name, and that she appreciated the rumours didn't stem from the committee. Garry raised that it would be good to talk things through face to face rather than email, as it's hard to interpret the intent of them sometimes, and maybe that's where things get confused. Garry asked about the dates and opportunity for face to face meeting and having club ABA reps present, it was decided the next viable date would be at the Towers Bowhunters Invitational 10/11 September. Jacqui will send out notices to all clubs and note on the Branch B facebook page.

Given the distances involved for clubs in Branch B Jacqui asked if it was worthwhile in looking towards assisting club reps to travel to meetings by providing a \$50 fuel voucher as an incentive. Garry responded that it realistically is to be expected after all we travel to shoots and if we hold the meetings the same time as the invitational's we will be able to cover it this way. Bev suggested that we send out the invites to the meeting and see what the response is then discuss a subsidy if needed, motion moved by Tania Seconded Jacqui.

Pat asked about the continuance of using teleconference as a method for interim meetings as it is convenient with our clubs so far apart. We will approach the ABA to see if we can also utilise this.

Garry asked if the issues with what Tania has raised with the emails were sorted and if there had been any feedback from nationals in relation to all that was raised. Tania advised that no she had not had received any feedback, so there was not much to discuss, however with the grants some clubs can not apply as some grants

closed on the Sunday. Garry mentioned that Eric Creighton is the person to speak to about all that was raised and that he was now back in Australia and it would be good to start talking to him Monday/Tuesday.

Tania advised that he should get the emails however she might try to contact him from Drumduff as she will be up there until Monday week.

Pat raised that what has happened is that as a new committee with what has happened we did step on a few toes at the ABA and that they are understanding that we all want what's best and we need to get back on track. The ABA are aware that we mean no harm and that the main stumbling block seems to be the protocols that we weren't aware of. They are of the understanding that we mean no harm to the ABA nor do we wish to affiliate as a target archery organisation which is what one of the rumours were. What is apparent from the last lot of emails is that some committee members ideas are slightly different to one another and that perhaps part of the issue is that none of us are really aware of what our roles are as the handover was very informal and there was no formal list or indication of what is required with each role.

Tania discussed that she pretty much summed up her position in her last email.

Jacqui stepped in to state that as far as she was concerned her handover was incompetent, it was a brief statement of what the role does (ie taking minutes, noting correspondence etc) however she was handed over a printer and laptop that do not work, resources that were empty and definitely no accurate role description. And that it was the worst hand over she had ever had and gave her little faith in the outgoing committee, and that along with feedback from the Branch clubs that she has spoken to is that the key things they want is for 1) their scores to be logged with the ABA more than anything else and then 2) the branch to grow from their clubs growing stronger. But what she is feeling is that the communication with the group is not strong and finding out things before someone goes to the executive committee on behalf of the branch would be good, because then it wouldn't be as much of a shock and a what is going on situation, As an example Bev & Jacqui weren't even aware that Garry was coming down to Townsville to do the measurers course until the weekend before and feedback from the clubs was if they had known then they could have sent someone, so its little things where the communication has stopped before its even started.

Pat read from the ABA Constitution section 8 (i) – (j), which identifies that the Branch Controller shall be responsible for the day to day management of a Branch and shall hold all authority in a Branch whilst the Branch Management Committee and Branch Executive Committees are not sitting, and that other members of the Branch Executive Committee shall have authority in the specific areas of responsibility but shall accept the authority of the Branch Controller. Tania advised that she had cc-ed everyone in to her emails so there shouldn't be any surprises.

Jacqui raised that Tania wasn't following protocol when contacting Nationals, and that she should have spoken to the Branch Committee before raising them. Tania advised that her emails to Nationals were usually at the direction of Nationals, however she wasn't aware she was supposed to email Mike White, not Amie Mills. Tania advised she similarly got an empty briefcase during handover, and that it is half the reason she asks so many questions, as it's the only way to get answers. Pat replied that yes that was fair enough what he saw with the handover is that Amy was definitely well overloaded for what she had in the timeframe.

Bev raised about still not having received the sub committees books, & understanding that they needed to be audited however she did not understand why they were not forwarded back to her and were instead sent back to Amy at Drumduff station. Tania advised that she had emailed the scanned auditor report and emailed it around. Bev advised she hadn't received it when she last checked, but would check her email again. Tania said that the signatures page had been sent to Garry for his signature, and to be mailed to her. Garry advised he had sent the signatures, and Tania advised she would check her mail when she got back from Drumduff. Tania advised it was the auditor who sent the books back to Amy as Amy had to sign them. The auditor location was discussed, Tania advised she thought they may have been in Townsville, but wasn't sure. Bev raised that this paperwork could still have been mailed to Amy but the books forwarded to the incoming treasurer, because as it stands at the moment there is GST reports to complete and pay however she can't do this as she has no access to the books. Tania advised that she would be able to bring them back with her on her return from Drumduff and get them out to Bev, Bev raised that had Amy just redirected the books and sent them back on

the next mail plane she would have them by now. Tania and Garry advised that the station does not have regular mail service, and had not had a mail plane for the previous two weeks. Garry advised that if there was no mail sent to the Drumduff, the mail plane doesn't come.

Pat raised that we needed more group communications and that we need to follow the protocols of Ccing everyone in & that we all want the best for the branch and the association. Bev spoke about we need to start building confidence in the clubs that they can come to us.

Tania raised that we have a lot of independent ABA members that we also need to represent, as not all for them want to join clubs.

Bev raised that if we focus on the clubs and we start building them, then the independents will start to join to gain the benefit of this.

Pat mentioned that Jacqui raised that we don't need to be the gatekeeper of the funds for the branch.

Pat feels that we need to be more like other branches who are successful and financial, stating that some other branches have over \$50000 in the bank. We discussed how this could be achieved and it could mean the money could be spent on things like promotional flyers & other promotional material to build the branch and clubs. Tania asked does the branch own any assets such as Targets, Gary said no we don't. Bev explained the Branch did buy the targets at the Safari and Towers got one set (as per usual – host branch receives a set) and she wasn't sure on the second set but she knows they were given to another club. Tania is to check with Amy where these went to.

Tania raised that she wants to make a 5 year plan. (Jacqui & Bev lost connection). Pitty discussed what other Branches presented at AGM in terms of plans, but that Branch B had not done so. (Jacqui and Bev rejoined meeting). Tania raised that Amanda had sent her an email of what to put in the Branch report. It was agreed that a strategic plan is a good forward move for the branch and clubs. It was also decided to prepare a branch report for the AGM with information about the clubs and achievements.

Jacqui advised that Eric Creighton had contacted her to note in the meeting that he had spent 4 hours that afternoon on the phone with John McLaren of NT Department of Business and office of consumer affairs to advise that the public register was incorrect, and that they had confirmed receiving the relevant documents. It was further noted that the NT Gov would be emailing Tania with a letter of apology and advice that the register was incorrect. Tania pointed out that she had been contacted that afternoon by Larissa of NT Gov, and that the information she provided was inconsistent with Eric's advice. Tania advised that Larissa said that Eric had been hostile in his conversation, and that the reason ABA was noncompliant was that signatures were missing or incorrect, and that until they were submitted, ABA would remain noncompliant. Tania countered Eric's noting that he had been on the phone for 4 hours as NT Gov had also rung her, and that John McLaren was actually on leave as advised by NT Gov that afternoon. Tania also advised that she had told NT Gov that the non-compliance was none of her business, and that all contact for this matter was to be to Eric Creighton or Mike White at ABA.

Pat supported Tania's enquiry to the public register as non-compliance can affect insurance, and that the Branch needs to be aware of ABA Nationals matters that affects members.

Pat raised the branch's ability to source grant funding and build the branch to be as financial as other branches. Jacqui touched on that a lot of this is due to high club membership in those branches and the branches working with the ABA to access bulk assistance and funds to build strong clubs, a lot of it isn't grant based, but even then it's with the branches sending grant requests through the ABA to obtain where available. They are still utilising the ABA to source the funds as it's the ABA who pay the taxes and need to acquit against the grant spending.

To whom this may concern,

As Mike White, on behalf of ABA, has refused to respond to a request, dated 5th October 2016, for independent mediation and review of my submission, and repeated failure to provide natural justice, I have lodged a submission with the NT Govt (John McLaren) requesting investigation of the ABA under s 93 of the *Associations Act 2002* (NT). I am notifying you of my submission as I feel I am obliged to do so under the ABA Constitution, and in the interests of maintaining procedural fairness.

My concerns included matters previously raised with the executive, as per my obligations to ABA under the Constitution. The matters raised are in general, *Associations Act 2002* ss 32, 33, 34, 38, 39, 44 and 107, contactual obligations under the ABA Constitution (i.e. this is not a 'guideline' as purported by Mike White), and the *Corporations Act 2001* where relevant to NT jurisdiction.

IFAA has similarly been notified of the submission, to ensure ABA member interests in future IFAA events are not jeopardised.

Evidence of non-compliance are obtained in majority written records from Eric Creighton, Aime Mills, Jacqui Baumgarten, and Mike White. Evidence has been legally obtained from personal interactions, emails, declarations, and freedom of/right to information records retrieved from ABA officer email addresses (e.g. government bodies). I have not used any records considered unlawfully, or questionably, obtained. Otherwise my submission would have been somewhat longer, with a number of other sections and acts detailed.

Pending result, I also expect to lodge a s109 application to the court, however I have concerns this will cause irreversible harm to ABA in full, rather than affect the officers who have caused offence on behalf of the ABA. It is likely that actions of Garry Pitt will be included in my application. I am also seeking to have specific emails (including deleted emails) released from service providers of officers, however the majority of evidence has already been obtained.

As my actions are lawful, for the protection of ABA members, have sufficient grounds, and are concerns raised during my term as Branch Controller, I do not expect to receive show cause or otherwise under s 19(c) of the Constitution. Considering my s109 dispute is with officers listed previously, I would expect any decision to exclude them, and natural justice to be provided should any action be forthcoming.

Please also note that due to continued oppressive and unreasonable conduct by Jacqui Baumgarten towards myself, including her impersonation of Aime Mills, she has been directed to not contact me. The result of harassment has prevented me from being able to attend shoots, and both my health and reputation have suffered due the false information she has circulated regarding me as official ABA advice. I am currently investigating damages for this harm. In order to prevent further harassment or injury, I request no correspondence to me via Branch B, **nor via Eric Creighton, Aime Mills, Garry Pitt or Mike White**. All correspondence received from ABA herein must be signed by the authorising/responsible officer.

Due to the nature of dispute, I also request that any decisions in regard to any of the above, be made free from conflict of interest, perceived or actual (e.g. Eric Creighton, Aime Mills, Mike White, Garry Pitt, etc.).

I expect this will be my final correspondence with ABA directly on this topic for some time, as I am not well. If you wish to view evidence of any of the submission matters above, please refer to ABA officer email accounts of Aime Mills, Eric Creighton, Mike White, Garry Pitt and Jacqueline Baumgarten. All items can be found there. Otherwise specifically advise what you require and I will consider providing it.



Dear Ms Baumgarten

Tania Olsen: Concerns Notice - Defamation Act (Qld) 2005

We act for Tania Olsen.

Our client has been defamed by remarks made in your email of 8.08 pm on Wednesday, 31 August 2016 ("the defamatory matter"), sent as the Branch Secretary of the North Queensland Branch of Australian Bowhunters Association Inc ("ABA") which email was published to the following persons:

- Garry Pitt (NQ Branch Field Representative of ABA);
- Patrick Whelan (NQ Branch Score Recorder of ABA);
- Beverly Stone (NQ Branch Treasurer of ABA);
- Amie Mills (ABA General Secretary);
- Mike White (ABA National President);
- Eric Creighton (Executive Director ABA).

Those remarks concerned circumstances relating to our client's elected position as the Branch Controller of the North Queensland Branch of the ABA.

The remarks made in your said email included words to the effect of:

1. Ms Olsen was not operating in the best interests of all clubs;
2. MS Olsen was not following directive/s of ABA and in the best interests of ABA;
3. Ms Olsen was non-communicative with her fellow club ABA representatives;
4. Ms Olsen pursued items with the National Executive of the ABA on behalf of the North Queensland Branch without consultation, including that:
 - (a) there was a request by the North Queensland Branch to change the constitution to allow the branch to incorporate;
 - (b) the North Queensland Branch obtain funding grants in the branch's own name;

5. Ms Olsen's stated intention to purchase the North Queensland Branch a "parent ground" with the intent to enable clubs to host invitationals at these grounds, was undertaken without consultation as to whether such a proposal would be contemplated and/or supported by clubs;
6. Ms Olsen's stated an intention to build a branch five (5) year plan without consultation with the clubs;
7. Ms Olsen's ongoing failure to ensure the outgoing Branch Treasure forwarded (as a matter of expediency) the treasurer's books to the incoming treasurer;
8. Ms Olsen's inappropriate and offensive behaviour (referred to as questioning "the integrity" of the ABA National Executive Secretary) in contacting the Northern Territory Government and challenging the ABA National Executive Secretary with alleged "misinformation";
9. Ms Olsen's belief that her role as Branch Controller enables her to solely make decisions and act on behalf of clubs within the branch without consultation (sic);
10. Ms Olsen lacks respect for the institution that is the National body of the ABA, in particular in her emails and dealings with:
 - (a) The National Secretary of the ABA;
 - (b) The National Treasurer of the ABA;
 - (c) The National CEO;
 - (d) The National President; and
 - (e) The lack of communication with North Queensland Clubs and/or all executive members before corresponding with the above persons on behalf of the North Queensland Branch.
11. Ms Olsen deliberately misled the North Queensland Branch Committee at the Branch Executive Meeting on 12 August 2016 about whether or not there had been any "feedback by Nationals" (a reference to the National Executive of ABA) to the email queries from the branch;
12. Ms Olsen deliberately misled the North Queensland Branch Committee at the above meeting when challenged by the branch secretary as to the existence of any "feedback";
13. Ms Olsen deliberately mislead the branch management team (a reference to the North Queensland Branch Executive) by "amending the minutes" of the above meeting to record a position favourable to Ms Olsen;
14. Ms Olsen relied upon a construction of the ABA Constitution that other members of the Branch Executive Committee shall have authority in their specific areas of responsibility but shall accept Ms Olsen's authority as Branch Controller;
15. Ms Olsen had undertaken several email communications with the National Executive of ABA where the only cc'd party is Ms Baumgarten;
16. Ms Olsen had adopted a deliberate course of conduct in her communications with the National Executive of the ABA to antagonise other members of the branch executive (who had not been cc'd into such correspondence);
17. Ms Olsen had amended meeting minutes for the North Queensland Branch to record details of the National Executive's communications with the Northern Territory Department of Business and Office of Consumer Affairs;
18. Ms Olsen's version of the relevant "minutes" (referred to above) have been contradicted by the verification of the "original minutes" by the NQ Branch Field Representative (Mr Pitt), NQ Branch Score Recorder (Mr Whelan) and NQ Branch Treasurer (Ms Stone);
19. Ms Olsen failed to comply with a request of Ms Baumgarten (Branch Secretary) to stop cc'ing the email of "mitchdrumduff" into Branch Management Committee meetings communications, particularly those where Ms Olsen is contesting a directive from the National Executive of the ABA;

We have been provided with copies of communications between yourself, Mr Pitt and Ms Stone showing that those persons have been involved in the drafting/review/approval of the defamatory matter.

We have also been provided with a copy of our client's email in response of 1 September 2016 (10.21 am).

Given the nature of your remarks, and the recipients of your said email, we believe that a Court would readily draw the inference that your remarks were malicious and were designed to denigrate our client in the eyes of the recipients.

The seriousness of the defamation is compounded by the fact, having considered the nature of our client's response, that the remarks could not be constructed as falling within any defence of contextual or substantial truth and such remarks are incapable of being characterised as fair and/or reasonable.

Concerns Notice

This letter is a "concerns notice" given in accordance with and pursuant to the *Defamation Act (QLD) 2005* ("The Act"), and is issued by and on behalf of our client.

By this concerns notice we hereby inform you of the defamatory imputations that our client (as aggrieved persons) consider are, or may be carried about them, by the defamatory matter in question ("the imputations of concern").

The imputations of concern which arise from the publication of the defamatory matter are as follows:

1. Ms Olsen breached her duty to the ABA in her elected position of Branch Controller for the North Queensland Branch by failing to act in the best interests of all clubs;
2. In taking the actions that she did, Ms Olsen was preferring her own interests over that of the ABA;
3. Ms Olsen had received reasonable directive/s from the ABA and had wilfully and intentionally refused to comply with any such reasonably directive/s;
4. Ms Olsen was required in her position as Branch Controller to communicate effectively with her fellow ABA representatives;
5. Ms Olsen failed to communicate effectively with her fellow ABA representatives and/or actively sought to undermine communications between ABA representatives;
6. Ms Olsen acted beyond the actual authority in her communications with the National Executive of the ABA;
7. Ms Olsen acted beyond her ostensible authority in her communications with the National Executive of the ABA;
8. Ms Olsen communications with the ABA were undertaken without any, or any proper, consultation with the North Queensland Branch Committee;
9. Ms Olsen communicated with the National Executive to support her own interests over those of the North Queensland Branch;
10. Ms Olsen was seeking to undermine the funding model of the National ABA by seeking to secure funding grants for the North Queensland Branch to the exclusion of the National ABA;
11. Ms Olsen was unreasonable and/or dishonest in respect of her proposal for the purchase of a "parent ground" for the North Queensland Branch;
12. Ms Olsen's proposal in respect of the foreshadowed "parent ground" was beyond the actual and/or ostensible authority of her position as Branch Controller;

13. Ms Olsen failed to undertake any, or any appropriate, consultation with the clubs in respect of her proposal for a "5 year branch plan";
14. Ms Olsen failed to ensure that the outgoing Branch Treasurer's books had been forwarded to the incoming Branch Treasurer;
15. Ms Olsen had acted inappropriately and/or dishonestly in securing possession of the Branch Treasurer's books;
16. Ms Olsen was tardy and/or derelict in her duty to provide the Branch Treasurer's books to the incoming Branch Treasurer;
17. Ms Olsen has acted inappropriately and/or dishonestly in her communications with the National Executive of the ABA and/or the Northern Territory Government in her investigations as to whether the ABA was compliant with relevant legislative requirements;
18. Ms Olsen without any, or any proper, basis questioned the integrity of the ABA National Executive Secretary;
19. Ms Olsen failed to comprehend her role as Branch Controller and/or the actual or ostensible authority afforded by that position;
20. Ms Olsen was disrespectful and/or rude to the National Executive of the ABA, North Queensland Executive Committee and/or North Queensland Club committee members;
21. Ms Olsen was deliberately misleading, dishonest and/or fraudulent in her responses to questions during the North Queensland Branch Executive meeting on 12 August 2016;
22. Ms Olsen had fraudulently amended the minutes of the 12 August 2016 meeting;
23. Ms Olsen had adopted a deliberate course of communications with members of the National Executive of the ABA to "antagonise" other members of the North Queensland Branch Executive Committee, by omitting such some or all of such persons from her communications with members of the National Executive of the ABA;
24. Ms Olsen had breached confidentiality of communications between the North Queensland Branch Committee by causing and/or permitting such communications to be copied to a "mitchdrumduff" email address;
25. Ms Olsen was obstructive in her role as Branch Controller.

Having regard to the personal, professional, ethical reputation of our client, and the gravity of the aforesaid imputations, our client would be entitled to monetary compensation in redress for the embarrassment and injury to reputation arising from your remarks.

Our client has various tertiary qualifications and a longstanding reputation within the Department of Natural Resources and Mines, and significant expertise in quarry, watercourse diversions, riverine protection, natural disaster waterway recovery and catchment management.

The damage that our client has suffered and will suffer as a result of the defamatory imputations include:

- loss of confidence by the recipients in our client;
- loss of confidence by existing and future members of the ABA, and in particular the North Queensland Branch of the ABA in our client;
- loss of personal and ethical reputation within the ABA community;
- social stigma, such as loss of trust, confidence and reputation amongst the broader community, including the ABA community and associates of that community.

Offer to Make Amends

Pursuant to the Act you have twenty-eight (28) days to make an offer to make amends.

Our client is entitled to an apology. Further, she would also be entitled to expect that a copy of any such apology would also be forwarded to all recipients of the defamatory matter (including those persons in attendance at the Towers Bowhunters Shoot on 10 September 2016).
